


Projected rise in global average temperature


The global climate of the 21st century


Changes in precipitation


- Increased risk of flooding;


- Adaptation by experience or

- focus on oportunities in spatial policies and technical innovation;






Focus in the Netherlands regarding adaptation to climate change

 - Climate change policy focus is on oportunities, R and D and investments.





Optie 2: "dichte" variant





Present approach to adaptation in the Netherlands

 - Fresh water management
 - Urban development
 - A major effort in the field of Research and Development of new techniques and practices in coastal protection, watermangement and agriculture


National Research programma Knowledge for climate founding partners:



National Research Programma Knowledge for Climate characteristics:

- Driven by research needs at the level of regional and national stakeholders: "hotspots"
- Multidisciplinary and multi-sector, spatial investment orientation;
- Research focussing on economically vital areas: Rotterdam, Schiphol, Haaglanden and particularly vulnerable areas: Waddenzee region, south-western delta;
- Including International cooperation in research: international hotspots.




